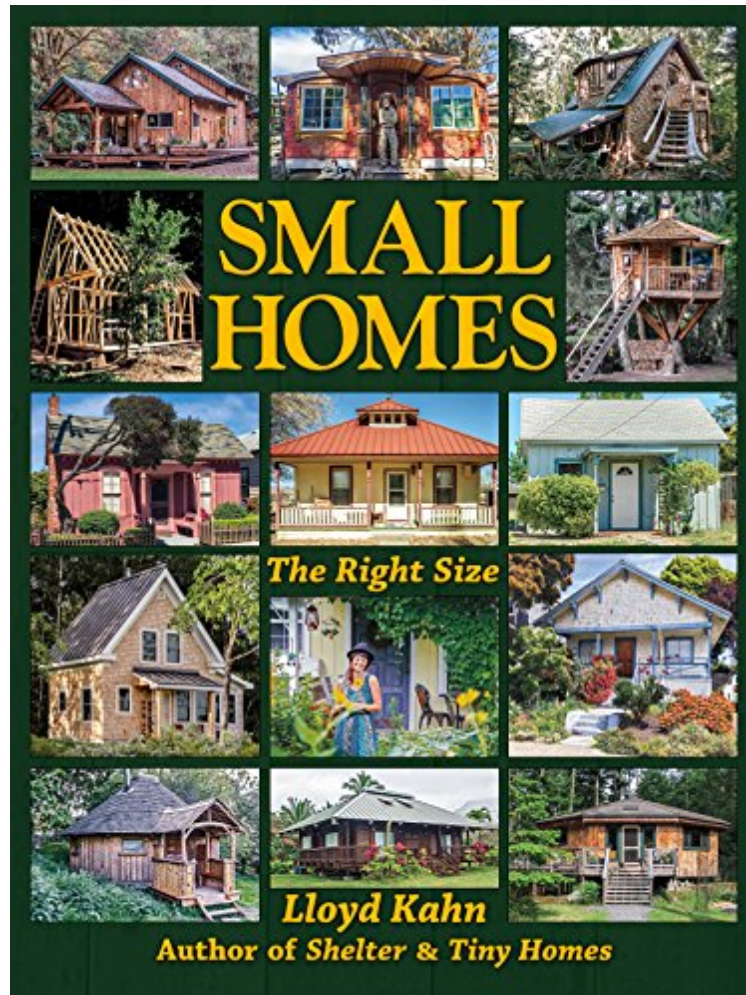

From the publishers of a popular series of building books comes *Small Homes*, which is highly relevant for these times getting smaller, rather than larger. Some 75 builders share their knowledge of building and design, with artistic, practical, and/or economical homes in the United States, Canada, England, Scotland, France, Germany, Spain, New Zealand, and Lithuania.

About the Author Lloyd Kahn started building his own home in the early '60s and went on to publish books showing homeowners how they could build their own homes with their own hands. He got his start in publishing by working as the shelter editor of the *Whole Earth Catalog* with Stewart Brand in the late '60s. He has since authored six highly-graphic books on homemade building, all of which are interrelated. The books, "*The Shelter Library Of Building Books*," include *Shelter*, *Shelter II* (1978), *Home Work* (2004), *Builders of the Pacific Coast* (2008), *Tiny Homes* (2012), and *Tiny Homes on the Move* (2014). Lloyd operates from Northern California studio built of recycled lumber, set in the midst of a vegetable garden, and hooked into the world via five Mac computers.
