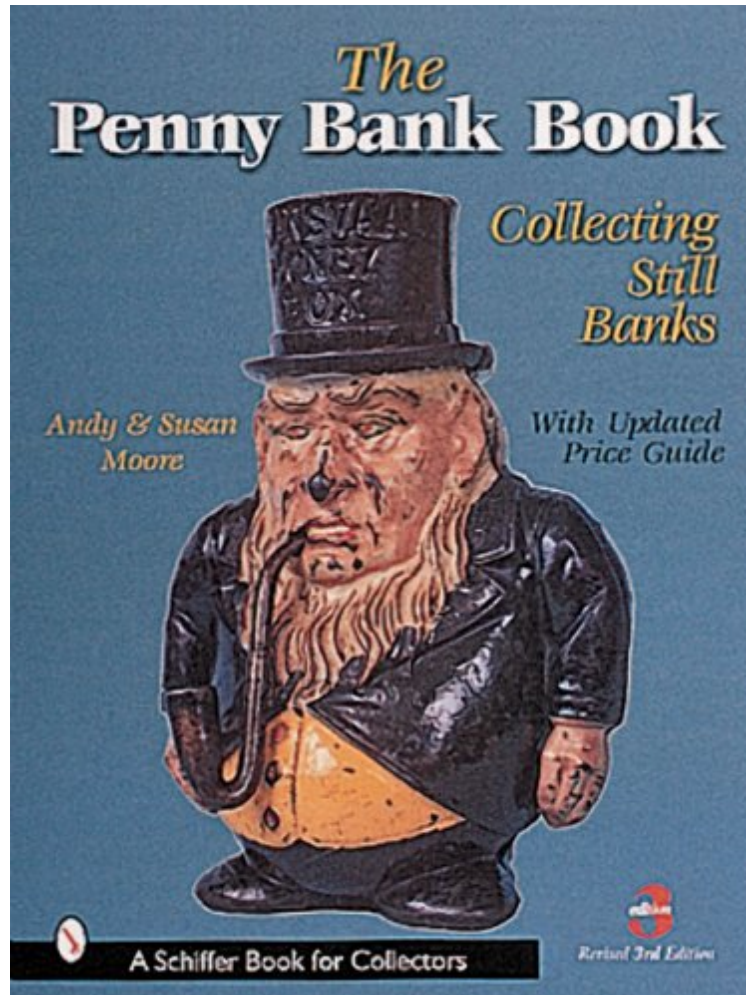

JandaWhile I mostly collect mechanical banks I do have some interest in still banks. This is the book most often referred to by collectors and sellers alike on E-bay or other auction sites regarding size, rarity, and price. The first sections deal with care and reproductions, followed by illustrations of still banks from manufacturers catalogs. Then comes a color section on banks followed by an appendix. There are several drawbacks to this book. The \$49.95 price for a book published in 2000 is high in my opinion. Secondly, many

of the banks are photographed together rather than individually so you really don't get that much detail. Better than the earlier editions in that it has the prices listed with the pictures instead of in the back of the book. Still the same banks that were in the earlier editions though.
